

FROM WALDORF TO WALDORF PROGRAM IN HUNGARY

YFU Hungary offers a special opportunity for students studying in a Waldorf school in their home country to continue their Waldorf education and spend a semester or a year as an exchange student in Hungary. This opportunity ensures that students will meet the same principles and values during their educational journey as in their home school and it enables students to connect to the Hungarian Waldorf community.

About the school

Students of the Waldorf program will attend the Göllner Mária Regional Waldorf High School, which is located in Budapest. Key components of the Waldorf teaching

system include the following:

- Focus on child development.
- · Individualization.
- · Whole-Child emphasis.
- · Integration of art and nature.
- · Active learning.

In the curriculum, much of the education in academic subjects takes place in blocks, generally of 3–5 weeks duration. Community building is in the focus of school life, therefore exchange students will be welcomed with the attention and care that is the basis of all YFU programs.
